

How to Use the Data Search Bar?



Creating a Business Story is an adequate activity to display various KPIs to your customers and fill your presentations with interesting visuals yet at times, you would need to highlight or track a specific number out of your Business Story data. BDB provides you with a 'Data Search Bar' to interactively show the desired data out of your views with a single click.

For example, if you are a food mart manager amidst your sales review report and need to show total store sales in the USA. You just need to type '**Total store_sales in USA**' in the '**Data Search**' **Bar'** and click the '**Search**' **Q** icon.



Your Business Story will quickly respond with the exact number as displayed below:



Drill deep into the data by searching sum of the store sales in the USA for Mid-Size Grocery.
