
- Browser that supports HTML5


3. Step-by-Step Process

3.1. Login to the below given URL


- In the URL bar enter → <https://www.bizvizsurvey.com/>
- Enter your credentials to Login




- Click on **'Submit'** to view the Survey Home Screen



- Click on the **'Create Survey'** to create a new survey



- v) Enter the following fields:
- **Survey Title:** Name the survey
 - **Survey Description:** Description of the survey
 - **Welcome Message:** Display's a message when the survey starts
- vi) Clicking on the 'Save' button will redirect user to the following page



vii) Following are the questions we have created to implement page logic


S.No	Question	Page No/Name
1	How old are you?	1 Page
2	How long do you walk daily?	2 Questions for 15-20 age
3	What was your first car?	3 Questions for 20-30age
4	Are you insured?	4 Questions for >40 age

3.2. Configuring Page Logic in a Survey

i) Steps to Implement Page Logic (Page Jump):

a) Click on the first question and select properties tab


Question>Properties>Features>Use Logic>Enable Checkbox




Scenario: When a user selects ‘C’ option in first question i.e. (C =30-40age) he has to redirect to ‘Page 3’.

To implement this scenario, follow the below given steps:

1. Select ‘Page Jump’ option from the ‘Logic Type’ dropdown
2. Select ‘Page 3’ from the dropdown as shown in the below image



3. As users needs to be moved from ‘Page 1’ to ‘Page 3’ on selecting an option i.e. (Option ‘C’). We need to configure the properties as shown below




For the 'C' option select 'Page Jump' from the Logic Type dropdown and select 'Page 3' as shown in the above fig

4. So when a user selects 'C' option i.e. (30-40 age) he will be redirected to 'Page 3'.

ii) Steps to Implement Page Logic (Question Skip):


a) Click on the question and select the properties tab

Question>Properties>Features>Use Logic>Enable Checkbox



b) Select 'Question Skip' option from the 'Logic Type' dropdown

c) Clicking on 'Manage Skip Questions' will display a pop-up window




d) Select the questions that you would like to skip and click on ‘Done’

iii) Steps to Implement Page Logic(Disqualification):

a) Click on the question and select the properties tab

Question>Properties>Features>Use Logic>Enable Checkbox



Scenario: In some scenarios if users select an option he will be disqualified from taking the survey.

To implement this scenario, follow the below mentioned steps:

1. Select ‘Disqualification’ option from the ‘Logic Type’ dropdown
2. Select ‘Option’ by which user will be disqualified on selecting (see the above Image)
